Before me is the United States Magistrate Judge’s Report and Recommendation, recommending that I enter an Order denying Plaintiff’s Motion for Summary Judgment and Motion to Remand [ECF No. 17], granting Defendant’s Motion for Summary Judgment [ECF No. 19], and affirming the Commissioner’s decision and dismissing the case from the Court’s active docket.
