Before me is the Report and Recommendation of the United States Magistrate Judge recommending that an Order be entered granting Defendant Nancy A. Berryhill’s (“the Commissioner”) Motion for Summary Judgment [ECF. No. 19], denying Plaintiff Jeffrey L. Brim’s Motion for Summary Judgment [ECF No. 15], affirming the Commissioner’s final decision, and dismissing this action from the docket of the Court. The Report and Recommendation (“R & R”) was filed on February 17, 2017. [ECF No. 23]. Plaintiff filed a timely objection to the R & R on March 3, 2017 [ECF No. 24], and the Commissioner filed a response on March 28, 2017. [ECF No. 25].
