This matter was referred to the Honorable B. Waugh Crigler, United States Magistrate Judge, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B), for proposed findings of fact and a recommended disposition.  - 3. The Commissioner's motion for summary judgment (Docket # 23) is **DENIED**;
- 4. This case is **REMANDED** to the Commissioner pursuant to sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g) for further consideration consistent with the report and recommendation; and
 - 5. This matter is **STRICKEN** from the active docket of the court.
