This matter is before the Court on the parties' cross Motions for Summary Judgment (docket nos. 15 and 18), and the Report & Recommendation of United States Magistrate Judge Robert S. Ballou (docket no. 24, hereinafter "Report"). 3. Defendant's Motion for Summary Judgment (docket no. 18) is hereby **GRANTED**; and

4. This case is hereby **DISMISSED**.
