## <u>ORDER</u>

Plaintiff's petition for attorney's fees was referred to the Honorable Robert S. Ballou, United States Magistrate Judge, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B), for proposed findings of fact and a recommended disposition. The Magistrate Judge filed a report and recommendation on March 7, 2012 recommending that the fee request be granted and that the court award plaintiff's counsel \$6,000.00 for his representation of the plaintiff. No objections to the report and recommendation have been filed, and the court is of the opinion that the report and recommendation should be adopted in its entirety.
