Orlando Pelzer, a Virginia inmate proceeding <u>pro se</u>, filed this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 alleging that defendant Nurse Roach denied him medical treatment. However, Pelzer does not allege any facts against defendants Garman, Braxton, or Meadows in his complaint. Therefore, the court dismisses Pelzer's claims against defendants Garman, Braxton, or Meadows without prejudice pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B)(ii) for failure to state a claim. Accordingly, the only remaining defendant to this action is Nurse Roach.
