

Notice of Appeal

On brief and also by having appointed my county voting precinct Churchville Voting Poll as my representative, I came before the Appendix (A) "no show in Court" Library Board for my appeal hearing on July 20, 2011 in proper person--that is, as a totally and permanently and officially 100% unable Enemy of the State and as an Appendix (B) VA-Rated 80% psychiatric disabled veteran. 
Dear Mr. Turner:

Dear Mr. Turner:

This is in reply to your recent request for a Virginia State Hunting, Fishing and/or Trapping license certification.

We have been informed by the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries that we may certify only those veterans rated totally and permanently disabled as a result of service-connected conditions.

A review of your Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) records indicates that you do not meet the above criterion. Although you have a non-service-connected rating at 80% disabled, you have not yet been rated with the designation of "*permanently and totally*" disabled. Therefore, the VA cannot issue you such a certification.

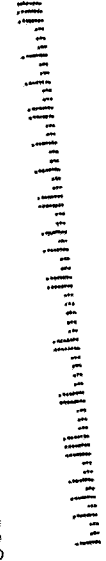
