This is in reply to your recent request for a Virginia State Hunting, Fishing and/or Trapping license certification.

We have been informed by the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries that we may certify only those veterans rated totally and permanently disabled as a result of service-connected conditions.

A review of your Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) records indicates that you do not meet the above criterion. Although you have a non-service-connected rating at 80% disabled, you have not yet been rated with the designation of "permanently and totally" disabled. Therefore, the VA cannot issue you such a certification.
