## **ORDER**

This matter was referred to the Honorable Robert S. Ballou, United States Magistrate Judge, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B), for proposed findings of fact and a recommended disposition. The magistrate judge filed a report and recommendation on July 30, 2014, recommending that the Commissioner's motion for summary judgment be denied, that the plaintiff's motion for summary judgment be granted in part, and that this case be remanded to the Commissioner pursuant to sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g) for further proceedings. - 3. Plaintiff's motion for summary judgment (Dkt. # 11) is GRANTED in part;

4. This case is **REMANDED** to the Commissioner pursuant to sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g) for further consideration consistent with the report and recommendation; and

5. This matter is **STRICKEN** from the active docket of the court.
