


In accordance with the accompanying memorandum opinion, it is hereby

**ADJUDGED AND ORDERED**

that Anderson's petition for a writ of habeas corpus, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254, is  
**DISMISSED** without prejudice as successive, and this action is stricken from the active docket
