Dorsey Luther Shelton, proceeding <u>pro se</u>, filed a civil rights complaint, pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. By Order entered 05/20/2014, the court directed plaintiff to submit within 10 days from the date of the Order to sign and return the Consent to Fee form.
