



removed from his file and pursued that claim through all levels of the grievance proceedings.<sup>1</sup> Until he does so, he has not exhausted available administrative remedies, as required under 42 U.S.C. § 1997e(a). Finally, Ball fails to show any reason that this case, which was dismissed without prejudice, should be reinstated. For these reasons, the court will deny plaintiff's pending motions. An appropriate order will issue this day.

<sup>1</sup> In the grievance proceedings documented by Ball's submissions, Ball asked for reversal of a classification decision, which authorities denied. The court takes judicial notice of the fact that prison officials generally address only one issue per grievance. Ball does not demonstrate that he has made any separate request for authorities to remove the allegedly false information from his file -- by first filing a request for services on the issue and then pursuing an informal complaint and the regular grievance procedure, if the issue is not satisfactorily resolved.
