Michael Anthony Adkins, proceeding <u>prose</u>, filed a motion for a preliminary injunction to compel officials at the Danville City Jail to transfer him to the custody of the Virginia Department of Corrections ("VDOC") due to what he perceived to be inadequate mental health treatment. Since filing that motion, Plaintiff has been transferred into the physical custody of the VDOC and is presently housed in a VDOC facility. Accordingly, the motion for a preliminary injunction is **DENIED** as moot. See, e.g., Mo., Kan. & Tex. Ry. v. Ferris, 179 U.S. 602, 606 (1900); Incumaa v. Ozmint, 507 F.3d 281, 286-87 (4th Cir. 2007).
