This prisoner civil rights action closed in October 2021 after the parties reached a settlement. Plaintiff Denis Rivera was then represented by counsel. Now, five months later, he has filed a pro se motion seeking interlocutory relief based on recent events entirely unrelated to the underlying cause of action in this case. I will deny his motion as unrelated to the underlying action.

"[A] preliminary injunction may never issue to prevent an injury or harm which not even the moving party contends was caused by the wrong claimed in the Bias A. Wathena and erlying action." *Omega World Travel v. TWA*, 111 F.3d 149c169 (4th Cir. 1997). To warrant interlocutory relief, the movant "must necessarily establish a relationship between the injury claimed in the party's motion and the conduct asserted in the

complaint." *Id.* Rivera's current motion fails to make these required connections. Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that the motion, ECF No. 147, is DENIED.
