## MEMORANDUM OPINION

Plaintiff Torrey Lavell Washington, a Virginia inmate proceeding <u>pro</u> <u>se</u>, filed this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On July 22, 2019, the court conditionally filed the action, advised Washington that his complaint failed to state a claim against the named defendants, and directed him to file an amended complaint within twenty-one days. <u>See</u> ECF No. 12. The order advised Washington that failure to file an amended complaint within the time allotted would result in dismissal. <u>Id.</u> Washington did not respond. Therefore, the court will dismiss Washington's complaint without prejudice for failure to comply with the court's order.
