Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. The parties' Stipulation for Entry of Order Granting United States' Motion to Dismiss and Stay, ECF No. 10, is **GRANTED**.
- 2. The United States' Motion to Dismiss, ECF No. 7, is **GRANTED**. Mrs. Gibbins' claim is dismissed without prejudice, pending resolution and 6 exhaustion of her case before the Federal Court of Claims under the National Vaccine Injury Compensation Program.
- 3. The remaining claims for loss of consortium under the Federal Tort Claims Act for Plaintiffs Kenneth W. Gibbins, Noelle C. James, Pamela Jones, 10 Merry Anne Nordberg, and Kim L. Baily are **STAYED** pending the resolution of Mrs. Gibbins' claim through the National Vaccine Injury Compensation Program.
- 4. The Plaintiffs shall notify this Court if and when Mrs. Gibbins' claim 13 through the National Vaccine Injury Compensation Program has been exhausted 14 or resolved. Plaintiffs' counsel will move to lift the stay, and separately move to 15|| add Mrs. Gibbins as a named party to the renewed case, if this Court has 16 jurisdiction at that point under the Vaccine Act, 42 U.S.C. § 300aa-1 et seq.
 - 5. Any pending motions are **dismissed as moot**.
 - 6. All trial dates and deadlines are **stricken**.

IT IS SO ORDERED. The District Court Executive is hereby directed to file this Order and provide copies to counsel.
