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2. The above-captioned case is **REVERSED** and **REMANDED** to the Commissioner of Social Security for further administrative proceeding pursuant to sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g). On remand the administrative law judge (ALJ) shall hold a new hearing and: (1) consider the new and material evidence from Dr. Burkett and Yakima Valley Memorial Hospital; (2) reconsider whether Plaintiff has an impairment that meets or equals a Listing in 20 CFR Part 404, Subpart P, Appendix 1; (3) reassess Plaintiff's residual functional capacity, if necessary; (4) obtain supplemental evidence from a vocational expert; (5) offer Plaintiff a supplemental hearing; and (6) issue a new decision. 3. Judgment shall be entered for **PLAINTIFF**. 4. Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment (ECF No. 15) is STRICKEN

- 4. Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment (ECF No. 15) is STRICKEN AS MOOT.
- 5. Upon proper presentation, this Court will consider Plaintiff's application for fees and expenses under the Equal Access to Justice Act, 28 U.S.C. § 2412(d).

The District Court Executive is directed to enter this Order, **enter Judgment**, forward copies to counsel, and **CLOSE THE FILE**.
