ECF No. 21. 17 Attorney D. James Tree represents Plaintiff; Special Assistant United States 18 Attorney Katherine B. Watson represents Defendant. The parties have consented 19 to proceed before a magistrate judge. ECF No. 6. After considering the file and 20 proposed order, IT IS ORDERED: 21 1. The parties' Stipulated Motion for Remand, ECF No. 21, is 22 **GRANTED**. The above-captioned case is **REVERSED** and **REMANDED** to the 23 Commissioner of Social Security for further administrative action pursuant to 24 sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g). 25 On remand, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) will not disturb the 26 partially favorable portion of the prior decision which found Plaintiff disabled as of 27 August 27, 2014. With respect to the period from June 1, 2010, the amended 28

disability onset date, through August 26, 2014, the date prior to the day Plaintiff was found disabled, the ALJ shall offer Plaintiff the opportunity for a new hearing and issue a new decision. The ALJ is directed to: (1) reevaluate the medical opinion evidence; (2) reconsider Plaintiff's residual functional capacity for that period; and (3) obtain vocational expert evidence, if warranted.

- 2. Judgment shall be entered for PLAINTIFF.
- 3. Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment, **ECF No. 16**, is **STRICKEN AS MOOT**.
- 4. An application for attorney fees and costs may be filed by separate motion.

The District Court Executive is directed to enter this Order, forward copies to counsel, and **CLOSE THE FILE**.
