**ORDER GRANTING THE PARTIES'

The parties agree that the matter should be reversed and remanded to the
Commissioner of Social Security pursuant to sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g)
for further administrative proceedings.

Consistent with the parties' agreement, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

1. The parties' Stipulated Motion to Remand, **ECF No. 14**, is
GRANTED.

- This matter is **REVERSED** and **REMANDED** to the
Commissioner of Social Security for further administrative
proceedings pursuant to sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g). On

1 remand, the Appeals Council is to instruct the ALJ to: develop the
2 record as necessary, reconsider all relevant issues, offer Plaintiff
3 the opportunity for a new hearing, and issue a new decision.

4 2. The Clerk's Office shall **TERM** the hearing and Plaintiff's brief, **ECF**
5 **No. 9**, enter **JUDGMENT** in favor of Plaintiff, and **CLOSE** the case.

6 **IT IS SO ORDERED.** The Clerk's Office is directed to enter this Order
7 and provide copies to all counsel.
