- This matter is **REVERSED** and **REMANDED** to the Commissioner of Social Security for further administrative proceedings pursuant to sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g). On remand, the Appeals Council is to instruct the ALJ to: take any necessary action to complete the administrative record; offer Plaintiff a new hearing; reevaluate the five-step sequential evaluation process: reevaluate the ALJ's step 5 finding, including obtaining vocational expert (VE) evidence as necessary while resolving any inconsistencies between the VE testimony, the Dictionary of Occupational Titles, and the residual functional capacity; and issue a new decision.
- The Clerk's Office shall **TERM** the hearing and the parties' briefs, enter
 JUDGMENT in favor of Plaintiff, and **CLOSE** the case.

IT IS SO ORDERED. The Clerk's Office is directed to enter this Order and provide copies to all counsel.
