17 **BEFORE THE COURT** is Third-Party Defendant Bonnie Gordon's Motion
18 to Compel and for Sanction (Ct. Rec. 256), Third-Party Defendant
19 Robert Pritchett's Motion to Compel and for Sanctions (Ct. Rec. 259)
20 and Robert Pritchett's Motion to Expedite (Ct. Rec. 261). The Court,
21 being fully advised, now therefore,

22 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

23 1. Pursuant to Local Rule 7.1(h), any party filing a motion
24 "shall also file a notice setting the time, date and place for a
25 hearing on a motion. The date of the hearing is at least 25 days
26 after filing the motion if all parties' counsel are in the same city,

1 or at least 31 days if counsel are not in the same city[.]" Third-
2 Party Plaintiff Bonnie Gordon did not file a notice of hearing with
3 her motion to compel and motion for sanctions. In accordance with
4 the Local Rules, that motion (**Ct. Rec. 256**) **shall be noted for**
5 **hearing without oral argument on April 6, 2006**, unless Bonnie Gordon
6 files a specific request for oral argument.

7 2. Third-Party Defendant Robert Pritchett's Motion to Expedite
8 (**Ct. Rec. 261**), is **DENIED**. In light of the June 5, 2006, discovery
9 deadline in this case, the Court determines that an emergency
10 hearing is not necessary.

11 3. Third Party Defendant Robert Pritchett's Motion to Compel
12 and for Sanctions (**Ct. Rec. 259**) **shall be noted for hearing on April**
13 **7, 2006, without oral argument** unless Robert Pritchett files a
14 request for oral argument.

15 **IT IS SO ORDERED.** The District Court Executive is hereby
16 directed to enter this Order and furnish copies to counsel **and to the**
17 **Third-Party Defendants proceeding pro se.**
