- 1. I am a partner with the law firm of Klein, Zelman, Rothermel & Dichter, L.L.P., counsel for Defendants Impulse Marketing Group, Inc. ("Impulse"), Jeffrey Goldstein ("Goldstein") and Kenneth Adamson ("Adamson") (collectively, "Defendants") in the above-captioned action. I submit this declaration in support of Defendants' Memorandum in Support of Defendants' Motion for Sanctions. Except as to matters alleged below as being upon information and belief, I am fully and personally familiar with the facts and circumstances set forth herein.
- 2. On or about March 29, 2006, Plaintiff filed a motion seeking leave to file a first amended complaint.
- 3. On or about May 2, 2006, this Court granted in part and denied in part Plaintiff's motion to amend his original complaint. In particular, the order denied Plaintiff's request to add new plaintiffs to the action.
- 4. On or about June 13, 2006, Plaintiff filed his First Amended Complaint, and, in direct contradiction to the Court's Order, counsel surreptitiously added "dba Gordonworks.com" as a plaintiff in the action.
- 5. - 6. On or about September 11, 2006, Plaintiff filed a memorandum in response to Defendants' motion concurrently with Plaintiffs unauthorized Second Amended Complaint. The Second Amended Complaint, filed unilaterally without Plaintiff ever seeking leave from the Court, changed the caption yet again and made substantial material revisions to Plaintiff's factual allegations and causes of action.
