After a bench trial held on October 14, 2014, the Court entered Amended Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, ECF No. 67, which are fully incorporated here with the same force and effect as if set forth verbatim. The Court being fully informed, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that:

1. Plaintiff, Bruce P. Kriegman, solely in his capacity as court-appointed Chapter 11 Trustee for Debtor LLS America, LLC, is awarded Judgment against Defendant 685937 BC, Ltd. (“Defendant”) as follows:

- 1 a. Judgment (CAD) \$989,235.04 CAD
2 b. Plus prejudgment interest from July 21, \$25,781.90 CAD
3 2009 to February 4, 2015, and continuing
4 thereafter until entry of this judgment, at
5 the federal rate of .47% per annum
6 c. Judgment (USD) \$20,400.00 USD
7 d. Plus prejudgment interest from July 21, \$531.67 USD
8 2009 to February 4, 2015, and continuing
9 thereafter until entry of this judgment, at
10 the federal rate of .47% per annum
11 e. Plus taxable costs in the amount to be
12 determined by the Court
13 f. Plus post-judgment interest from the date
14 of Judgment until fully paid at the federal
15 rate of 0.17% per annum (28 U.S.C. §
16 1961); and

17 2. All proofs of claim filed by Defendants in Debtor's Bankruptcy
18 proceedings or any claims that may hereafter arise are disallowed pursuant to 11
19 U.S.C. § 502(d) unless and until the avoided transfers are returned to the Trustee-
20 Plaintiff.

copies to counsel, to pro se Defendants, and to Judge Frederick P. Corbit.
