

1 the event the payroll examination reveals that delinquent fringe benefit
2 contributions and/or dues are owed, plaintiffs shall have the right to institute legal
3 proceedings against defendant to recover the delinquent fringe benefit
4 contributions and/or union dues found due and owing pursuant to the payroll
5 examination report, together with all other amounts to which plaintiffs would be
6 entitled to recover under the subject collective bargaining agreement, trust
7 agreement and applicable law.

8 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

9 Pursuant to the parties' Stipulation for Dismissal (ECF No. 10), all claims
10 and causes of action in this matter are **DISMISSED** with prejudice and without
11 costs or fees to any party, subject to the preservation of the rights enumerated
12 above. All pending motions are **DENIED** as moot.

13 The District Court Executive is hereby directed to enter this Order, furnish
14 copies to counsel, and **CLOSE** the file.
