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15	5 By Order filed June 19, 2013, ECF No. 19, the Court directed			
16	Plaintiff to amend or voluntarily dismiss his complaint within sixty			
17	7 (60) days. Plaintiff sought additional time to comply with this Order			
18	and was granted until September 19, 2013, to do so, ECF No. 23.			
19	By letter dated August 28, 2013, Plaintiff advised the Court			
20	that he did not have his legal property and indicated that he would			
21	sign the motion to voluntarily dismiss and would ask that the filing			
22	fee be expunged. It is unclear whether Plaintiff was actually sent an			
23	additional copy of the Order to Amend or Voluntarily Dismiss, along			
24	with the Motion form, as stated in a letter dated September 4, 2013.			
25	Because Plaintiff has stated his intent to voluntarily dismiss			
26	this action the Court will liberally construe his letter, ECF No. 24,

as a Motion to Voluntarily Dismiss the Complaint pursuant to Rule
41(a), Federal Rules of Civil Procedure. Defendants have not been
served in this action. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED Plaintiff's Motion,
ECF No. 24 is GRANTED and the Complaint is DISMISSED WITHOUT
PREJUDICE.

The Court will also liberally construe the letter as a Motion to waive collection of the remaining balance of the filing fee in this action. For good cause shown, **IT IS ORDERED** Plaintiff's Motion, **ECF No. 24**, is **GRANTED** and the institution having custody of Mr. Holtz shall cease collection of the filing fee in this action, cause number **CV-13-5058-EFS.** 

IT IS SO ORDERED. The District Court Executive is directed to 12 enter this Order, enter judgment of dismissal without prejudice, 13 forward a copy to Plaintiff and close the file. The District Court 14 15 Executive is further directed to send a copy of this Order to the Office of the Department of Corrections, Attn: LFO/COS UNIT, P.O. Box 16 17 41107, Olympia, WA 98504-1107, to forward to the appropriate agency 18 having custody of Plaintiff. The District Court Executive also shall provide a copy of this Order to the Financial Administrator for the 19 20 United States District Court, Eastern District of Washington.
