17	governmental unit or municipality can be sued as a 'person' under section 1983."	
18	Hervey v. Estes, 65 F.3d 784, 791 (9th Cir. 1995). This includes county sheriff's	
19	departments. See Jackson v. Barnes, 749 F.3d 755, 766 (9th Cir. 2014) (holding	
20	that Sheriff's Department was subject to suit under § 1983 for its investigative	
20	activities).
