**ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFFS' ORAL

15 A hearing occurred in the above-captioned matter on July 8,
16 2014, in Richland. Scott Johnson appeared on behalf of Plaintiffs
17 Randy Hickman and Kevin Self, while Andrea Clare appeared on behalf of

1 3. All pending motions, including ECF No. 3, are **DENIED AS**
2 **MOOT.**

3 4. All hearings and other deadlines are **STRICKEN.**

4 5. The Clerk's Office is directed to **CLOSE** this file.

5 **IT IS SO ORDERED.** The Clerk's Office is directed to enter this
6 Order and provide copies to all counsel.
