Doc. 8

March 1, 2017 Plaintiff's former counsel, Jeff Johnson, filed a Motion to
Withdraw as Counsel for Plaintiff, stating that newly discovered information
created a breakdown of the attorney-client relationship. ECF No. 3. The Court
granted the motion and Plaintiff proceeded pro se. ECF No. 4. At the telephonic
scheduling conference held on August 15, 2017, Plaintiff informed the Court that
he wishes to dismiss this action. The Court orally granted Plaintiff's motion.
Accordingly, the Court dismisses the above-captioned case without prejudice.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. Plaintiff's oral motion to dismiss the above-captioned case is **GRANTED**.
- 2. The above-captioned case is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE** and without costs or fees to any party.
 - 3. Any pending motions are **DISMISSED AS MOOT**.

IT IS SO ORDERED. The District Court Executive is hereby directed to file this Order, provide copies to counsel and Plaintiff, and **CLOSE** this file.
