1 1999). A motion for reconsideration may not be used to raise arguments or present
 evidence for the first time when they could reasonably have been raised earlier in
 the litigation. *Id.*; *Kona Enters., Inc. v. Estate of Bishop*, 229 F.3d 877, 890 (9th
 Cir. 2000).

Analysis

Here, Key Government Finance, Inc. argues the Court committed clear error
by misconstruing and misapplying the reasoning provided in *In Re City of Stockton*, 478 B.R. 8 (E.D. Cal. 2012), and expanding the scope of Section 904 as
to render inoperative other important bankruptcy statutes applicable in Chapter 9.
Key Government Finance, Inc. is not making any additional arguments that the
Court has not already considered.
