5/29/03). Plaintiff then filed a redacted complaint, in which he removed not only the social security numbers but also his Alien Number and date of birth. The redacted complaint was served on the defendant.

The filing of the amended complaint superceded the original complaint.

Furthermore, plaintiff has not explained why he did not comply with the Court's order requiring him to file an amended complaint that included his Alien Number and date of birth. Had he complied with that order, his complaint would not have been dismissed on July 25, 2006. However, in light of the fact that plaintiff is proceeding *pro se*, the Court will allow him another opportunity to file an amended complaint that complies with the pleading requirements of Fed. R. Civ. P. 8(e)(1) and states his Alien Number and date of birth.

Accordingly, the order of dismissal is VACATED, and the Clerk of the Court is directed to reopen this case. Plaintiff must file an amended complaint within thirty days of the date of this order. Otherwise, his complaint will be dismissed.
