IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED

Pursuant to the Court's May 15, 2007 Order (Dkt. No. 121), summary judgment has been GRANTED to Defendants. Pursuant to the Court's August 1, 2007 Order (Dkt. No. 148), Defendants are entitled to a total award of attorneys' fees and costs in the amount of \$111,440.00. This sum is equal to the hourly attorneys' fees award of \$96,240.00, plus costs in the amount of \$15,200.00.
