ORDER GRANTING MOTIONS TO
SEAL

16 This matter comes before the Court on three separate motions to seal brought by the
17 parties. (*See* Dkts. #70, #84 and #87). The parties seek to seal exhibits related to a discovery
18 motion filed by Plaintiff on April 17, 2008. (Dkt. #72). Both parties move to seal the relevant
19 documents in this Court on the grounds that the exhibits contain sensitive and confidential
20 information. The parties have already filed the exhibits under seal.

21 Having reviewed the motions, and the remainder of the record, the Court hereby finds
22 and orders:

23 (1) "Plaintiff's Motion to File Exhibit B to the Declaration of Wendy E. Lyon Under
24 Seal" (Dkt. #70), "Immersion Corporation's Motion to File Under Seal Certain Supporting
25 Documents" (Dkt. #84), and "Plaintiff's Motion to File Exhibit A to the Declaration of Wendy
26 E. Lyon Under Seal" (Dkt. #87) are GRANTED. The parties have adequately justified
27 sealing the exhibits, overcoming the strong presumption in favor of public access. *See* Local
28 Rule CR 5(g)(2). Accordingly, the exhibits shall remain SEALED.
