16 This matter comes before the Court on “Plaintiff’s Motion to Re-File Exhibits E, G,  
17 and I Under Seal.” (Dkt. #102). Plaintiff indicates that it inadvertently failed to move to seal  
18 certain exhibits it previously filed in this Court in support of issuance of letters rogatory on  
19 February 19, 2008. Therefore Plaintiff moves to re-file them under seal, arguing that the  
20 exhibits contain confidential and sensitive information. The Clerk of this Court has  
21 temporarily sealed these documents while Plaintiff’s motion was pending. (Dkt. #48).  
22 Defendant does not oppose the motion.

23 Having reviewed the motion, and the remainder of the record, the Court hereby finds  
24 and orders:


25 (1) “Plaintiff’s Motion to Re-File Exhibits E, G, and I Under Seal” (Dkt. #102) is  
26 GRANTED. Plaintiff has adequately justified sealing the exhibits, overcoming the strong  
27 presumption in favor of public access. *See* Local Rule CR 5(g)(2). Accordingly, the exhibits
