DECLARATION OF DAVID ADAMS

I, David Adams, declare as follows:

1. I am a security officer employed by the Seattle Public Library. On June 14, 2006, I was on duty at the security desk near the 4th Avenue entrance to the Library. On that day, I observed an incident involving a patron I later learned was Juan Tajalle. Attached as Exhibit 1 is a copy of the incident report I completed shortly after the events described. Attached as Exhibit 2 is a copy of the exclusion order described in the incident report.

2. At the time of the events described in my report, it was my intent to enforce the Library's rules of conduct. Mr. Tajalle was asked to leave the Library because his behavior

1 violated those rules in my judgment. It was not my intent to deprive Mr. Tajalle of any right he
2 has under the law.

3 3. At the time of the incident, Mr. Tajalle was not detained. He was not frisked, and
4 his bag was not searched. He was not moved to a non-public area, but was asked to go outside
5 the Library. It is Library policy to call the Seattle police when a member of the public is
6 detained, and the police were not called on account of the events described in the incident report.

7 I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.

Description of Incident:

On the above date and approximate time, I, Security Officer David Adams, was at the 4th Ave Security desk when an Asian male adult wearing military style clothing, which consisted of a tan outfit with a black beret and a pair of black military boots, walked into the library and looked at me in an agitated way. I looked back at the male, due to the male being known to act aggressive toward the Security staff for an unknown reason. Once the male saw me looking at him, he sneezed loudly, and then sneezed again. The male had been known to do this when Security Officers walked past him and the male had did it to me the day earlier as I walked by him in the spiral. At this time, a disabled white male adult stated to the male "gazoontike!" due to the male having sneezed so loudly. Once the disabled white male got up, the Asian male looked at him, stood there and did not get on the elevator. As the frail white male walked past the Asian male, the Asian male leant down to the white male and stated, "You fucking with me?" The white male said that he was not and walked away as quickly as he could. At this time, the male looked around at me and yelled, "What are you smiling at?" I did not answer the male so the male took off his headphones walked agitatedly up to the Security desk, got into my face and yelled, "What are you fucking laughing at!" At this time, I got up from my seat and told the male to leave the building. Officer Rambayon, who had been at the desk while the event took place, asked the male what his problem was and that if a person smiled at them it was a nice gesture, not an insult. The male became very loud and belligerent and began yelling and used profanity. I then advised the male that he was excluded from the library for his actions and told him to leave. The male continued to use foul language and began walking toward the elevator. Due to the male refusing to leave, I walked over to the male and advised him that he was excluded from the building and had to leave the library. The male began yelling louder and stated that he "had not fucking done anything." At this time, Officer Rambayon told the male to exit the library so we could talk to him outside. The male began walking towards the doors, still being threatening towards Security and patrons. Officer Rambayon walked into the one-person door slots to exit, but the male attempted to enter the same door slot, which was only made for one person. Once the male got half way into the door slot, the other door swung around catching the male's backpack between the door and the doorframe. At this time, the door collapsed and the male grabbed his arm and fell to the ground stating that the door had hit his arm. Once the male was on the ground the male began yelling and used profanity. The male was asked to get up, but the male stated that his arm was broken. At this time, the male was asked if he wanted medical

treatment and he stated that he did. I then walked over to the Security desk and called 911 for an aid unit. As the male was sitting on the ground waiting for the aid unit, Officer Rambayon asked the Asian male, "Did I cause your injury?" The Asian male replied, "No, man. It wasn't your fault. It was an accident." Once the SFD medics arrived, they asked the male what was wrong. The Asian male stated that his shoulder was broken. Two SFD medics then took hold of the male by BOTH his shoulders and pulled the Asian male up without any complaint from the Asian male. The SFD medics indicated that if the male's shoulder had indeed been broken, they would not have been able to pick the male up by the shoulders without the Asian male complaining. Once the male was outside, he argued with the medics and stated that his shoulder was broken and that he needed to go to the hospital. While the Asian male waited for transportation, I obtained the males name and other needed information so I could fill in exclusion order form # 1543. Once this was completed, I handed the male his copy of the exclusion order and advised him that he was now excluded from the library for at least 14 days and that the exclusion order may be extended for up to one year. About five minutes later, an ambulance arrived and transported the male to the hospital. END OF REPORT.

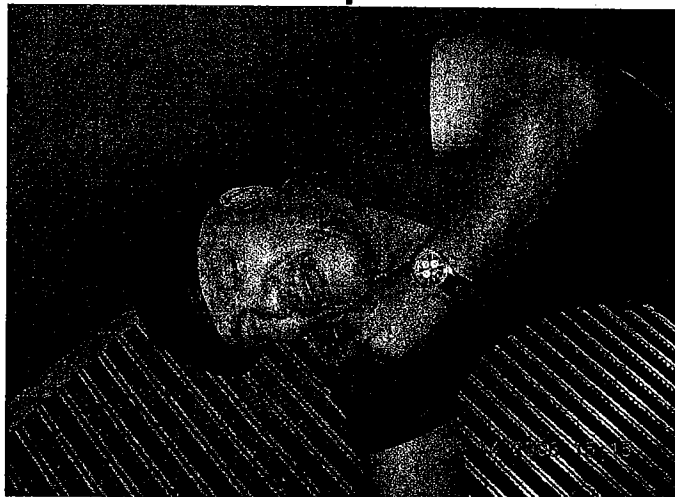
