
ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

This matter comes before the Court *sua sponte*. On March 12, 2009, defendant Kurabu Corporation (“defendant”) filed a motion *in limine* that, taken as a whole, exceeds 50 pages in length. (Dkt. #17). As of this date, a courtesy copy of these documents has not been provided for chambers.
