Ms. Walia moves for reconsideration of the court's order denying her 17 objections to the Honorable Magistrate Judge Brian A. Tsuchida's order, (Dkt. #13), and 18 for reconsideration of the court's order denying, as premature, Ms. Walia's motion to 19 exclude evidence (Dkt. #15). The court DENIES the motions for reconsideration (Dkt. 20 ## 16, 17). 21 22

Motions for reconsideration are disfavored. Local Rules W.D. Wash. CR 7(h)(1). The court will ordinarily deny these motions in the absence of a showing of "manifest error" in the prior ruling or a showing of "new facts or legal authority which could not have been brought to its attention earlier with reasonable diligence." Id. Ms. Walia fails to meet either criterion for granting a motion for reconsideration. Accordingly, the court DENIES the motions. (Dkt. ## 16, 17.) Dated this 4th day of November, 2009. R.
