1.Amazon.com LLC ("Amazon") filed a complaint against the Secretary of theNorth Carolina Department of Revenue ("DOR"), in his official capacity, captioned Amazon.comLLC v. Hoyle, No. 2:10-cv-00664-MJP (Dkt. No. 1).

2. Plaintiffs-Intervenors Jane Does 1-6 and Cecil Bothwell ("Intervenors") filed a complaint in intervention in this action (Dkt. No. 61).

3. DOR subsequently filed motions to dismiss Amazon's complaint (Dkt. No. 43) and the complaint in intervention (Dkt. No. 64), and Amazon filed a motion for summary judgment (Dkt. No. 44).

4. After briefing on the motions was completed and oral argument was held, the Court issued an Order dated October 25, 2010 granting summary judgment to Amazon and denying DOR's motion to dismiss the complaint of Amazon and the complaint in intervention of Intervenors (Dkt. No. 69).

5. The Court's October 25 Order held that "much of the declaratory and injunctive relief sought [by Intervenors] overlaps with the declaratory relief issued by this order [in favor of Amazon]." Dkt. No. 69 at 24.

6. This stipulation does not constitute a concession, agreement or admission by Defendant Hoyle as to the correctness or applicability of the declaratory relief granted in the October 25 Order or that the Court has jurisdiction over Defendant or this matter.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED, subject to the Court's approval, that:

As a result of the Court's October 25 Order, it would be an unnecessary use of judicial resources to further litigate Intervenors' overlapping claims. Intervenors and Defendant Hoyle therefore agree, for purposes of this action, that judgment shall be entered on behalf of Intervenors providing the same declaratory relief as granted to Amazon in this action. *See* Dkt. No. 69 at 24.
