Jones: 17 On August 7, 2012, defendant United Parcel Service, Inc. filed a motion for leave 18 to file a 24-page motion for judgment as a matter of law, or in the alternative for a partial 19 new trial. Dkt. # 135. The court GRANTS defendant's request in part, and will allow 20 defendant to file an 18-page motion. Plaintiff's response shall not exceed 18 pages, and 21 any reply shall not exceed 9 pages. The court advises the parties that all briefing must 22 contain pin-point citations to the trial transcript. See Local Rules W.D. Wash. CR 23 10(e)(6)-(10). Relevant portions of the trial transcript provided to the court must be 24

highlighted or otherwise clearly marked. *Id.* If the briefing and supporting evidence

exceeds fifty pages, the parties must provide a courtesy copy to the court that includes

exhibit tabs, to the extent there are multiple exhibits. *Id*.
