(4) Motions to Compel (Dkt. ## 214, 216, 219, 232, 236, 238)

Plaintiff has filed numerous discovery motions. The motion to re-open discovery (Dkt. # 219) is STRICKEN as moot. Discovery in this case remains open until May 13, 2012. Dkt. # 224. The five motions to compel (Dkt. ## 214, 216, 232, 236, 238) are all STRICKEN for failure to comply with meet-and-confer requirements in Fed.R.Civ.P. 37 and Local Rule CR 37. The motions may be renewed by counsel as appropriate.

(5) Motion for a Physical and Mental Health Examination (Dkt. # 222)

Plaintiff's motion for a Rule 35 examination is DENIED as improper. As plaintiff has requested imaging of his abdomen in addition to his shoulders, neck, and wrist (areas that he alleges were injured by excessive force), it appears that plaintiff is actually requesting medical care, not a Rule 35 independent examination for the purposes of this lawsuit. Counsel may renew the request for a Rule 35 examination as appropriate.
