ORDER

16 The court has reviewed the Supplemental Report and Recommendation (“R&R”)  
17 (Dkt. # 20) of the Honorable Mary Alice Theiler, United States Magistrate Judge and has  
18 considered Petitioner’s motion (Dkt. # 21) for an extension of time to respond to the  
19 R&R.

20 The court previously referred this matter to Judge Theiler for a supplemental  
21 recommendation on whether the bond hearing Plaintiff had recently received satisfied  
22 Respondent’s due process obligations. The R&R concluded that the bond hearing was  
23 legally sufficient. The court reaches the same conclusion.

24 Petitioner filed an unopposed motion for an extension of time asking for an  
25 additional two weeks beyond April 13, 2012, to object to the R&R. The court GRANTS  
26 that motion, but notes that Petitioner did not file an objection to the R&R by April 27,  
27 2012, the new deadline that he requested. Given the conclusions of the R&R, it is highly

1 unlikely that Petitioner's objection, even if he had timely filed it, would have led the  
2 court to a different result.

3 The court adopts the supplemental R&R, DISMISSES this action, and directs the  
4 clerk to enter judgment for Respondent.
