DISMISSAL ORDER

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16 On September 4, 2012, the Court granted Plaintiff leave to amend his complaint to show  
17 that the Court has subject matter jurisdiction over this action. Plaintiff timely filed a motion on

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1 prejudice for lack of subject matter jurisdiction and failure to comply with the Court's orders.
