15	This matter comes before the Court on "Plaintiff's Motion for Leave to File	
16	Under Seal Exhibits O, R, T, and U to the Declaration of Katherine Hendricks." Dkt. # 46.	
17	Plaintiff seeks permission to file certain documents under seal because defendant	
18	designated the documents or certain topics as confidential during discovery. Defendant has	
19	not responded to the motion.	
	"There is a strong presumption of	of public access to the court's files " and

There is a strong presumption of public access to the court's files," and, 20 absent a "compelling showing that the public's right of access is outweighed by the 21 interests of the public and the parties," a seal is not appropriate. Local Civil Rule 5(g)(2). 22 A party's unilateral designation of a document as "confidential" does not, in and of itself, 23 establish the necessary "compelling showing" under Local Civil Rule 5(g)(2). is actually confidential, to discuss the possible implications of public disclosure, and to
 address the public's interest in access to these records. Because Mr. Clinton has until
 recently been proceeding pro se, the Court has reviewed the relevant documents and finds
 as follows:

Plaintiff's motion to seal is GRANTED in part. Exhibits O and U are not
confidential. The Clerk of Court is directed to unseal both Exhibit O and Exhibit U at Dkt.
48. Out of an abundance of caution, Exhibits R and T will remain sealed. Future failures
to support a claim of confidentiality will be considered a waiver of the claim.
