ORDER QUASHING SUBPOENA

15 This matter comes before the Court on a letter request seeking to quash a
16 subpoena issued to Comcast in the above-captioned matter. Dkt. # 7. The subpoena
17 appears to be moot as it relates to IP address 76.121.42.83. The Court granted leave for
18 preliminary discovery for the purpose of identifying the Doe defendants: that purpose has
19 now been accomplished insofar as Jerry Mulder is concerned. Plaintiff has the
20 information it needs to serve Doe 13.

21 Quashing the subpoena will not preclude this action for copyright
22 infringement. To the contrary, the case will officially begin with personal service of the
23 complaint, at which point defendant will have the opportunity to respond to the merits of
24 plaintiff's claims.¹

26 ¹ If and when service is accomplished on Mr. Mulder, he may want to review Fed. R.
Civ. P. 12 when evaluating his options for presenting defenses and objections.

1 For all of the foregoing reasons, the subpoena issued to Comcast regarding
2 IP address 76.121.42.83 is QUASHED as moot.
