Then, the ALJ 19 should reassess the opinions of Drs. Johansen and Harmon, specifically analyzing what impact 20 Dr. Schimmel's opinion has on them. If the ALJ again attaches little or no weight to the 21 opinions of one or more of these physicians, the ALJ must state legally valid reasons for doing 22 so. If the ALJ attaches significant weight to one or more of them, the ALJ should re-determine Doc. 24

02	re-determine Plaintiff's eligibility for benefits.
03	II. The Court REVERSES the decision of the Commissioner; and
