ORDER RESTORING CASE
AND DIRECTING THE
UNITED STATES TO
ANSWER § 2255 PETITION

16 This matter comes before the Court *sua sponte*. Defendant Devaughn Dorsey is currently
17 in federal custody after pleading guilty to charges related to motor-vehicle trafficking and being
18 convicted of charges related to witness tampering. In this matter, Dorsey filed a motion to
19 vacate, set aside, or correct his sentence under 28 U.S.C. § 2255. Dkt. # 1. Dorsey had also filed
20 a motion for a new trial in his criminal case, and the Court accordingly stayed briefing in the
21 above-captioned matter pending the resolution of that motion and any subsequent appeals. See
22 Dkt. # 12 at 3. The Court having stayed briefing in this matter, also ordered that the action be
23 removed from the Court's active caseload until application by the parties or order of this Court.
24 The Court recently denied Dorsey's motion for a new trial, Case No. CR08-245, Dkt. # 583, and
25 the time for filing an appeal of that denial has run without Dorsey filing a notice of appeal, see
26 Fed. R. App. P. 4(b)(1)(A).
