Kinlen – June 18 2024 Data & Contempt. (Dkt. No. 1132.) In his declaration, Kinlen states that DSHS has 19 requested approval of several "Good Cause Exceptions" with his current declaration and his 20 declaration file for May 2024 (Dkt. No. 1123). To the extent Defendants request the Court grant 21 any reduction in fines owed due to a Good Cause Exception, they must move for such relief by 22 filing a motion with all supporting materials and allowing Plaintiffs to have an opportunity to 23 respond. Similarly, where Defendants have requested a reduction in fines owed for GCE, as they

did for January, April, and May 2023 (Kinlen Decl. ¶¶ 21, 22, 25), they must move for such relief, provide all supporting materials, and allow Plaintiffs an opportunity to respond. The Court has not included the sums requested as reductions for January, April, and May 2023, in its most recent amended judgment. The clerk is ordered to provide copies of this order to all counsel.
