DATA & CONTEMPT

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18 The Court issues this Order in response to the Declaration of Dr. Thomas J. Kinlen – June
19 2024 Data & Contempt. (Dkt. No. 1132.) In his declaration, Kinlen states that DSHS has
20 requested approval of several “Good Cause Exceptions” with his current declaration and his
21 declaration file for May 2024 (Dkt. No. 1123). To the extent Defendants request the Court grant
22 any reduction in fines owed due to a Good Cause Exception, they must move for such relief by
23 filing a motion with all supporting materials and allowing Plaintiffs to have an opportunity to
24 respond. Similarly, where Defendants have requested a reduction in fines owed for GCE, as they

1 did for January, April, and May 2023 (Kinlen Decl. ¶¶ 21, 22, 25), they must move for such
2 relief, provide all supporting materials, and allow Plaintiffs an opportunity to respond. The Court
3 has not included the sums requested as reductions for January, April, and May 2023, in its most
4 recent amended judgment.
