14 This 28 U.S.C. § 2254 habeas action is currently stayed pending resolution of petitioner's
15 state court personal restraint petitions. Petitioner has filed a motion for leave to add claims to his
16 original habeas petition that are currently pending before the Washington appellate courts. Dkt.
17 35. He also asks the Court to continue to hold this action in abeyance until the state court
18 proceedings are concluded. *Id.* The State does not oppose the motion. Dkt. 37.

19 Based on the foregoing, the Court finds and ORDERS:

20 (1) Petitioner's motion for leave to amend his habeas petition, Dkt. 35, is
21 GRANTED. Petitioner's original petition, Dkt. 1, is amended to include the additional claims
22 filed at Docket 36.

1 (2) Given the pendency of continuing state court matters, the Court continues the
2 prior stay.

3 (3) The parties shall file status reports every **180 days**.
