 Order and must set forth the exact nature of the conflict. A failure to do so will be deemed a
 waiver. Counsel must be prepared to begin trial on the date scheduled, but it should be
 understood that the trial may have to await the completion of other cases.

6 The settlement conference conducted between the close of discovery and the filing of
7 dispositive motions requires a face-to-face meeting or a telephone conference between persons
8 with authority to settle the case. The settlement conference does not have to involve a third9 party neutral.

19	COOPERATION
20	As required by LCR 37(a), all discovery matters are to be resolved by agreement if
21	possible. Counsel are further directed to cooperate in preparing the final pretrial order in the
22	format required by LCR 16.1, except as ordered below.
