ORDER

This matter comes before the Court on Plaintiff’s objections to Defendant’s submitted deposition designations. Dkt. # 122. On April 27, 2017, the parties submitted Plaintiff’s objections to deposition designations of Keith Sellers’ deposition transcript (“Deposition”) and Defendant’s responses.
